- Normal priority samples must arrive at the Hamilton laboratory by 12:00 PM
For any samples received after 12:00 PM, an additional day will be added on to the turnaround time.
- Urgent testing must be pre-arranged with the laboratory before 4pm the day prior to samples arriving at the lab. You will receive a confirmation email from a Client Services Manager approving your urgent testing request.
Samples requiring urgent testing must arrive at our Hamilton laboratory before 9:00 AM to ensure urgent turnaround can be achieved.
If the samples are received after 9:00 AM, they will be processed under normal priority.
